

Chicago Public Schools
Elementary School Space Utilization Report
School Year 2010-11

Background

Since 1987 the School Demographics and Planning Department of the Chicago Public Schools has developed and refined a methodology to determine current capacities and utilizations of all public elementary schools located throughout the City of Chicago.

The model for determining capacity and utilization was designed to make use of information collected annually from elementary schools. The methodology makes possible accommodations for variances, special programs, and the identification of classroom use for non-dedicated homeroom use.

There is no single, unanimous national standard for assessing school capacities. Individual school districts have historically devised their own methodologies: some are based on strict square footage, others are based on classroom spaces, and still others use programmatic considerations.

There is a significant difference between the physical capacity of a school and its functional capacity. For example, according to the Building Code of Chicago, the allowed occupancy in a classroom is limited to one person per twenty square feet of space. Given that the average size of a classroom is 800 square feet, the resulting allowed occupancy is forty persons, i.e. 39 students and one teacher. Even in the most overcrowded schools, this level of occupancy does not exist, would be educationally unsound, and would violate the agreement between the Board of Education and the Chicago Teachers Union in terms of maximum class size.

Thus the concept of school capacity varies according to the intent for which it is applied. For the Fire Department, it is one number, for purposes of devising a capital plan it's another number, and for educational reasons it's yet another.

Over the years, the Chicago Public Schools have used different approaches each with its own focus. In 1987, the Chicago Public Schools devised an objective, standardized methodology for assessing the capacities and utilizations of elementary schools. This development arose from a need to identify and quantify capital needs, such as the determination of where to build new schools and additions, and where to close or consolidate schools.

In 1994, the Chicago Public Schools retained the services of a national expert on school capacities to review, assess and comment on the methodology used by CPS. In its *Capacity and Utilization Study* report, the author, Ben Graves, HAIA, Principal of

Educational Planning Consultants, based in Austin, Texas, concluded that *“The capacity and utilization methodology described in this report is a feasible method for the Chicago Public Schools to use”*.

Subsequently, the method was revised to make it more sensitive and responsive to changing educational practices.

Definitions of Primary Headings

School: School name. Special Education schools and other schools providing unique services having non-standard space arrangements such as Early Childhood Centers are not reported. Given the space-intensive nature of these programs, the application of the standard methodology is inappropriate. Matters relating to the utilization of space in such schools are addressed individually.

ID: The current school identification number assigned to the main school. Capacity data for branches (including Child Parent Centers), temporary/mobile units, and leased space are aggregated to the main unit.

TA: Total Attending. Each school year, on the 20th day of school (typically in late September or early October), the School Demographics department captures the enrollments of all public schools on this day. This data set is referred to the “20th day” file and this is the data set used to represent the enrollment of the school for the purpose of calculating each school’s space utilization rate (see “SUR” below).

Other, similar files containing school membership data are collected at the beginning of each school year (i.e., Monthly Membership files and Racial-Ethnic Survey files). While variances in school enrollments among these files are evident, such variances are small and tend to reflect the small changes in school enrollments during the first weeks of the new school year. The 20th day file is unique in that it provides Demographics staff with the detailed student information necessary to geographically reference the home addresses of records of all active public school students. This geographical referencing of students home addresses is critical to account for changing demographics as it relates to capacity and utilization.

TC: Total Capacity. The term Total Capacity relates directly to the number of classroom spaces available to the school. Classrooms are spaces designed as such regardless of current use. For example, spaces designed as classrooms but used as offices, storage rooms, and parent meeting rooms are counted in capacity calculations. Also included are science labs, computer labs, art rooms and music rooms. Conversely, spaces not designed as classrooms, such as offices, lunchrooms, or storage rooms, and used as teaching stations are excluded from capacity calculations. Also excluded are lunchrooms, gymnasias, auditoria, and multi-purpose rooms.

Total Capacity is defined as the sum of the number of classrooms measuring 600 square feet or more (“Average” or “A” sized classrooms) multiplied by thirty, plus the number of classrooms measuring less than 600 square feet (“Below Average” or “BA” sized classrooms) multiplied by fifteen. Total Capacity = [(A X 30) + (BA X 15)].

SUR: Space Utilization Ratio. In its simplest form, a school’s utilization rate is its enrollment divided by its capacity, expressed as a percentage. $SUR = TA / TC$.

A school’s Space Utilization Ratio cannot, on its own, adequately inform decisions related to the opening or closing of schools.

Other Definitions & Explanations

Overcrowded: An often misunderstood concept is why CPS uses 80% of total capacity as the threshold beyond which a school is generally considered to be overcrowded. Not all elementary school classrooms are occupied at full capacity for the duration of the school day. It is common practice, during the course of the day, to schedule students either in groups or as entire classes to specialized spaces for parts of the day. These spaces include art rooms, science labs, computer labs, and resource rooms. When this occurs, the primary rooms are left vacant or under-utilized. It is primarily due to this scheduling issue that it is unrealistic to expect a school to operate at 100% of its capacity. 80% was chosen because beyond this point, schools begin to use labs, art rooms, and music rooms as standard classrooms.

It is possible and not uncommon to have schools operating at or above 80% of capacity, and in some cases, these schools may either not be technically overcrowded or may possess the ability to eliminate overcrowding by simple measures.

Efficient Utilization: A facility occupied by a school utilizing between 60% and 80% of its capacity is generally considered to be an efficiently utilized facility. A facility occupied by a school utilizing between 50% and 60% of its capacity is also generally considered to be efficient, though special attention is placed on the trending direction of the school’s enrollment and population projections to avert underutilization.

Underutilization: A facility occupied by a school utilizing less than 50% of its capacity is considered to be underutilized.

Attendance Area Schools & Non-Attendance Area Schools: This report draws a distinction between attendance area (neighborhood) elementary schools and non-attendance (citywide) elementary schools.

Unlike attendance area elementary schools, non-attendance area schools generally exert a degree of enrollment control that attendance area schools do not. As such, different strategies and actions are recommended to mitigate both overcrowding and underutilization depending on the type of school. For example, attendance area schools may mitigate overcrowding or underutilization by adjusting attendance boundaries, while non-attendance area schools may simply modulate the intake of new enrollees over time.

Shared Facilities: The number of shared facility arrangements in Chicago's public schools is trending upward. While these scenarios present new challenges to the standard methodology of monitoring school capacities and utilization rates, at the same time the district recognizes the advantages that shared facility arrangements can represent. Very often, shared facility arrangements are an attractive alternative to closing or consolidating school facilities in the interest of optimal efficiency. Because shared facility arrangements represent non-standard uses of space, the application of the standard methodology is inappropriate and matters relating to the utilization of space in such facilities are addressed individually.

Predecessor School / Year Closed: Where available, information is provided pertaining to the public or non-public school which previously occupied the facility currently occupied by the non-attendance area school.

10-11 Grades Offered / New grades planned: Because the number of recently authorized public schools in Chicago is trending upward, and because in some cases these schools do not yet accommodate a full K-8 grade offering, the utilization rates of such schools should be observed with this understanding.

Footnotes: Certain attendance area schools with space utilization rates near or greater than 80% contain footnotes referenced below.

CE and MT: Controlled Enrollment and (Year-Round) Multi-Track are student assignment protocols used to reduce severe overcrowding at attendance area elementary schools. A Controlled Enrollment school effectively closes its enrollment to new enrollees who are instead enrolled in, and generally provided transportation services to, nearby receiving schools, while a Year-Round Multi-Track school reorganizes its school calendar into multiple tracks (typically four), interspersed by several short vacations throughout the year, thereby eliminating the traditional 3 month summer vacation.

To maintain a consistent view of utilization, utilization rates provided for Multi-Track schools account for the entire enrollment of the school despite the fact that only three-fourths of the school's enrollment is present in the school facility at any one time.

ANR: Attending, but Not Residing. Every attendance area elementary school's enrollment is analyzed each year to determine the percentage of students enrolled who live outside of the school's attendance area. These "out-of-area" students are referred to as ANR. All attendance area school enrollments consist of some ANR students and, typically, the enrollment of ANR students does not contribute to a high space utilization rate (i.e., greater than 80%). When the number of ANR students *does* cause an attendance area school's SUR to exceed 80%, it generally suggests that the ensuing overcrowded status is avoidable. For this reason, the SUR report contains some ANR footnotes, which indicates that the school can (and should) reduce its enrollment and SUR over time by reducing the enrollment of ANR students. It is the viewpoint of School Demographics that such schools' "avoidable" overcrowding status should not be confused with the generally "unavoidable" overcrowding conditions that affect schools where the percentage of ANR students is relatively low.
