



## CPS School Environmental Scorecard FY09

Chicago Public Schools is working to reduce its impact on the environment and teach our students to be environmental stewards. *How is your school doing?* This School Environmental Scorecard helps principals and schools see their accomplishments in three priority areas: energy use, recycling, and paper waste reduction. Each school's performance is scored using a "traffic light": green means the school meets or exceeds standards; yellow means it needs some work; red means that the school needs a plan for improvements.

### Energy

The Scorecard shows the cost to heat and light each school in FY 09, and how much energy it uses per square foot. Your target is 75 kbtu per square foot, which is the CPS and regional average and not a stretch goal.

**Green** = 75 kbtu/SF/year and below

**Yellow** = 75 – 90 kbtu/SF/year

**Red** = 90+ kbtu/SF/year

Blank = no data. School may pay own energy bill (e.g. charters) or be part of a campus.

Any school should be able to reduce its energy use 10 percent through no-cost behavioral actions, like turning off lights and equipment when not in use. Current usage data is available through the CPS energy management system; ask your Area Facility Manager how to access it.

### Recycling

Each school has a recycling target based on its size, and Facilities tracks how much schools recycle each week. CPS awards incentive Recycling Reward\$ gift cards to schools that meet their targets; successful schools received \$500 in gift cards each semester last year.

The Scorecard shows Spring 2009 scores. (Current weekly scores are available on [www.cps.edu](http://www.cps.edu) under your school's scorecard.)

**Green** = 100% of target and above (receive gift card)

**Yellow** = 75% to 99% of target

**Red** = below 75% of target

Blank = no data. School may have own waste provider (e.g. charters) or be part of a campus.

### Paper Waste Busters

CPS uses so much white copy paper each year that, if we stacked it up, it would reach the top of the Sears Tower **EIGHT** times. Each one of us can help the environment every day by using less paper. CPS [Paper Waste Busters](#) challenges all of us to

- save paper
- buy 35% or greater recycled-content paper

With Paper Waste Busters, CPS can save tens of thousands of trees and decrease the air and water pollution from the manufacture of paper. Baseline paper use is measured in white Office Depot 8.5x11 copy paper, per student, in FY 09:

**Green** = Fewer than 600 sheets/student

**Yellow** = 601-800 sheets/student

**Red** = 801 or more sheets/student

Blank = School did not purchase 8.5x11 copy paper from Office Depot in FY 09 or enrollment data is not known.

Buying recycled content paper is the easiest environmental change schools can make:

**Green** = 30%-100% recycled content paper

**Yellow** = 10% - 29% recycled content paper

**Red** = below 10% recycled content paper

Blank = School did not purchase 8.5x11 copy paper from Office Depot in FY 09.
