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GENERAL INFORMATION

CTE College and Career Academies (CCA) offer an exciting pathway to college and careers, giving students a head start on preparing for their futures. In addition to taking all CPS college prep core courses like math, science and English and learning how they are used in real life, students participating in CCA programs will have the opportunity to experience hands-on training in their chosen industry. CCA students will also have the opportunity to receive scholarships, industry-recognized credentials and college credit through their coursework.

INFORMATION REGARDING THE COLLEGE AND CAREER ACADEMIES APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

- ▶ **Lottery Academies:** For most of the academies, if more applications are received than there are spaces available, students will be selected by computerized lottery. Preference will be given to applicants with minimum 7th grade stanine scores of 5 in total math and reading comprehension (except Dunbar which has no stanine preference). Students receiving special education or bilingual education services will receive preference when their stanines total a minimum of 10 in both total math and reading comprehension (e.g. 7 and 3 or 6 and 4). If not all spaces are filled by applicants meeting the stanine minimums, remaining spaces will be offered to applicants with stanine scores below 5. A minimum of 30% of available spaces will be filled by students who live in the school's attendance boundary or 2.5 mile proximity for those schools without an attendance boundary.
- ⊛ **Selective Academies: *Law & Public Safety, Medical & Health Careers, CISCO Networking IT and Database Programming IT Academy applicants*** - For these academies only, selections will be based on points. Students applying to these academies must submit a STATEMENT OF INTEREST with this application for each academy selected. For consideration to these academies, students will be assigned points for each of the following: (1) 7th grade final GPA, (2) 7th grade stanines, (3) statement of interest, (4) letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or principal and (5) interview. The highest scoring students will be invited to interview based on a review of their points for their GPA, stanines and statement of interest. At the time of the interview, students must bring a letter of recommendation. Students with the highest overall points will receive offers for these academies. - ▶ **Notifications:** Letters with selection results will be mailed in mid-February. Students may receive offers from as many as five academies. Students' seats are not secured unless parent follows directions provided in the letter to accept an offer.
- ▶ **Academic data for Charter school and non-CPS students:** This section of the application should only be completed by the current elementary school for students who attended a charter school or a non-CPS school during the 2009-2010 school year.
- ▶ **Application Deadline: December 17th at 5pm.** Completed applications must be received by the Office of Academic Enhancement, ATTN: CCA, 125 S.
