



SCHOOL-BASED DENTAL EXAM FOR PRE-K-8TH GRADE STUDENTS



Dear Parent/Guardian:

Our school will be offering a school-based dental program. This program will be offered during the school day by licensed dentists contracted through the Chicago Department of Public Health. All Students in PreK-8th grade are eligible to participate in the program. ***If your child is in kindergarten, 2nd or 6th grade, he/she is REQUIRED to have a dental exam by May 15, 2010.*** If your child has already had a dental exam this school year, please bring the completed dental form to the school nurse; however, your child is still eligible for the dental program at the school. If your child is enrolled in ALL KIDS, your insurance will be billed.

Dental Services offered in the school:

- Dental Exam
- Dental Cleaning
- Fluoride Treatment
- Dental Sealants as needed
- Referral for treatment services if needed

THIS PROGRAM DOES NOT ALLOW THE USE OF NEEDLES and DOES NOT USE ANESTHESIA. THIS PROGRAM ALSO DOES NOT OFFER RESTORATIVE TREATMENT SERVICES (such as fillings, pulling teeth or crowns / caps).

Please read and sign the front and back of the consent form. Please return this form as soon as possible so that your child can receive preventative dental services at the school. Please note, your child cannot participate in this program unless you provide your written consent.
