Who

Students currently enrolled in **8th Grade** taking an **Algebra 1** course at a **Non-CPS School** who plan to attend a CPS high school in fall 2024 must take the district-wide Algebra Exit Exam in order to be considered for placement into the next level math course in their freshman year.

What

The 2024 Algebra Exit Exam is a 120-minute exam which consists of 40 questions covering a variety of algebra concepts. The exam is administered online.

Registration Details

Counselors, parents, or guardians should complete this registration form for each student. The form includes:

- general information
- information about testing accommodations
- proof of enrollment in a current algebra course (e.g. progress report, letter on school letterhead); proof of enrollment must clearly state "algebra" as the completed/enrolled math course

Before Testing

Students should bring a photo/student ID (photo copy is fine) and at least two pencils for scratch work.

There is no waiting room for parents available during testing.

After Testing

Results will be mailed to the address provided on the registration form in **mid-July 2024**. Results will also be electronically transmitted to each student's projected CPS high school.
