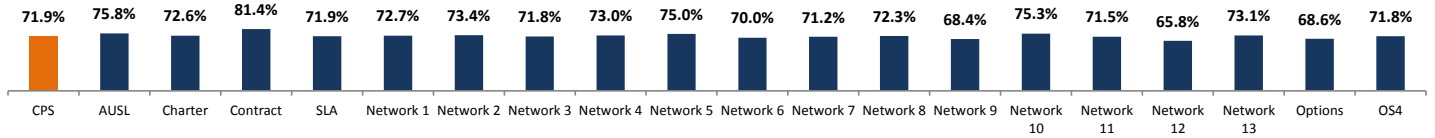


Chicago Public Schools had 13255 college enrollees\* from SY2015 and 72% of those enrollees persisted in college.

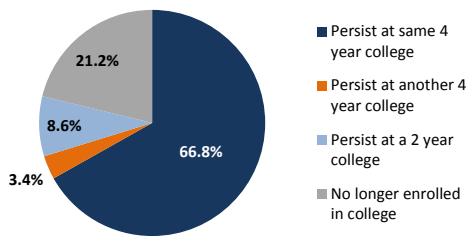

District & Network Rates



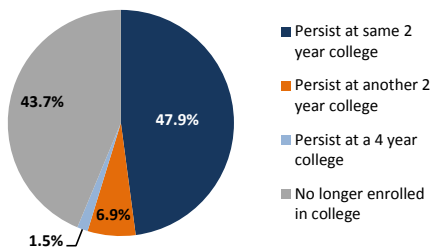

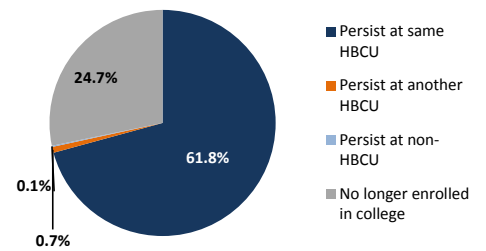
Enrollees at 4 Year Colleges



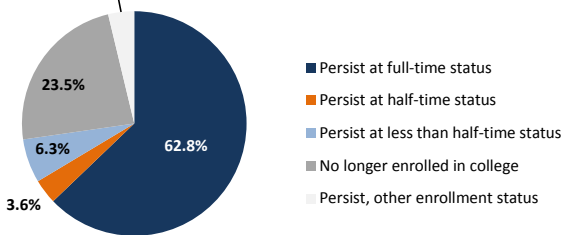
Enrollees at 2 Year Colleges



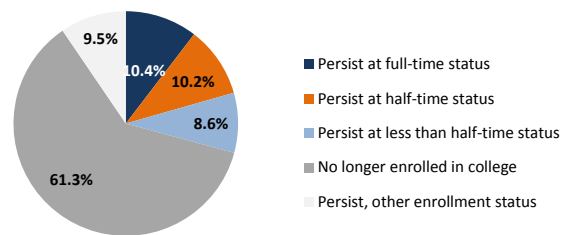
Enrollees at HBCUs



Full-Time College Enrollees

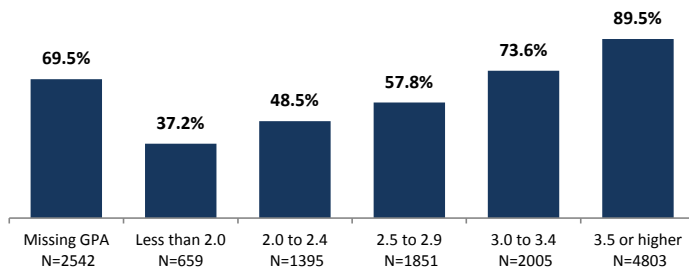


Half-Time College Enrollees

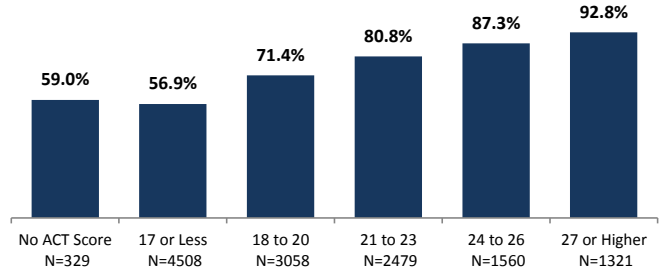


Persistence Demographics - N varies by category\*\*

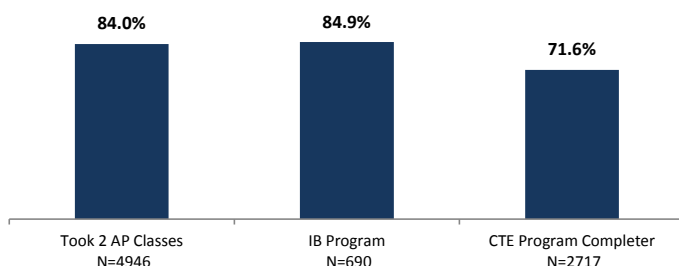
Persistence by GPA



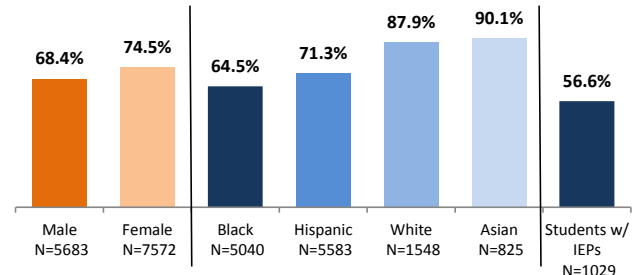
Persistence by ACT Score
