#### **Emerging Themes**

#### Community and Belonging

- Deep relationships between families and staff are seen as central to student success. Families want to keep current school names and mascots.
- Majority of families have a strong desire to keep current Principal, AP, and teachers.

#### Continuity in Student Support Services

 Families value the holistic support structure (academic, emotional, behavioral) currently in place and want to ensure those systems carry over into the CPS structure as much as possible.

#### Enrichment and Engagement

 Extracurricular opportunities are viewed as critical to student joy, motivation, and identity development.

#### Cultural Relevance & Celebration

 There's a strong desire to maintain bilingual, culturally affirming programming and to continue celebrating students' heritage.

#### Transparent Communication

 Families want timely, clear communication and a direct way to understand how decisions are being made and what to expect next.

### Decision Making for Principal Selection

#### **Acero School Transitions**

## The Office of Network Support (ONS) will identify the CPS Network Chief who will ensure the following:

- Open a city-wide principal position for eligible applicants to apply
- CPS Network Chief, takes the first review of candidates resumes, screening, and narrow down applicants
- Advisory Council review top three applicants, create a community meet and greet with the applicants
- Advisory Council will make a recommendation to the CPS Network Chief
- CPS Network Chief will make the final decision regarding Principal Selection



## Principal Selection Timeline

- 9/17 -10/1: Position posted and application submission window
- 10/1 10/6: CPS Leadership Resumé Review and Creation of Principal Candidate Pool
- 10/6 10/13: CPS Internal Vetting of Candidates
- 10/6 10/20: Candidate Interviews with Network Leaders + Advisory Councils
- 10/13 10/20: Reference Checks
- 10/20 11/3: Candidate Introduction Forum at school
- 11/3 11/10: Finalist(s) Interviews with CEdO/CEO
- 11/10 11/17: Distribution of Offer Letter, Staffing, Onboarding

## Advisory Council Selection Member Selection Process

- Democratic-Oriented Process: Given that each school community shared feedback with the District earlier this year during the Spring Listening Sessions, which included feedback concerning Advisory Council and Design Committee membership and team size constraints, CPS is facilitating a selection process that allows key school stakeholders to decide who will serve on each school's Advisory Council.
- Advisory Council Member Voting Required: The amount of interested candidates exceeded the desired cap, and thus, a fair, equitable process has to be facilitated for membership selection at each school.





## Advisory Council Member Selection Timeline

- The Advisory Council Member Selection process launched on Thursday, September 4, 2025, and concludes on Thursday,
   September 25, 2025.
- 9/4 9/25: Advisory Council Candidate Interest Form Submission Window
  - To ensure that school community makes an informed decision about who serves on the Advisory Council, all candidates are strongly encouraged to complete a Candidate Interest Form.
- **9/15:** SY25-26 Inaugural Community Incubation Meeting
- 9/19 9/25: Public Posting and Review of Responses from Candidate Interest Forms
  - All candidate responses (both English and Spanish translations) will be posted on the CPS Acero Transitions Webpage for public review.
- 9/19 9/25: Advisory Council Voting Window
- 9/26: Poll Results Published and Advisory Council Members Announced

- 9/19 9/25: Advisory Council Voting Window
  - Voting Window Opens at 5pm CST on 9/19
  - Voting Window Closes at 5pm CST on 9/25.
- All voting will take place via electronic ballot via a Google Survey Form.
- On September 19, 2025:
  - The voting ballot link will be distributed via email, that will also include a full list of candidates for each Acero campus Casas, Cisneros, Fuentes, Santiago, and Tamayo.
  - The voting ballot link and full candidate list for each school will also be uploaded to the <u>Acero</u>

## GoCPS + Enrollment Updates for Current Students & Families

#### **Acero School Transitions**

#### **Current Students & Families**

- All currently enrolled students <u>do not</u> need to apply for seats for the new CPS district-managed school.
- Students will automatically be rostered to the newly established CPS elementary school for SY26-27.
- Students and parents will receive email official notification once this process has been completed in early 2026.



## GoCPS + Enrollment Updates for Incoming or Transferring Students & Families

#### **Acero School Transitions**

#### **Incoming & Transferring Students for SY26-27**

- Any parent of a student who is <u>not currently enrolled</u>, and who will be in Grade K 8 next school year, must apply and follow the GoCPS process this school year to secure an enrollment seat for next school year.
- GoCPS Application Window: September 23rd November 14th
- o In this year's GoCPS application cycle, schools will appear as: **Casas, Cisneros, Fuentes, Santiago, and Tamayo** on the application. (the Acero handle will be removed)
- <u>Elementary School GoCPS Family Training Registration English Sessions via Zoom</u>
  - Available Training Dates: September 30, October 8, October 16, October 24
- Elementary School GoCPS Family Training Registration Spanish Sessions via Zoom
  - **Available Training Dates:** October 6, October 16, October 20

- August: Decision on the Network for each school
- September: Opening of Principal positions
- Late September: Establishment of Advisory Council and Design Committees at each school
- September June 2026: Recurring district incubation committee meetings, listening sessions with stakeholders, design committee and advisory council meetings
- October: Inaugural Advisory Council Meetings
- Middle of October 2025: Principal hired

- End of October 2025: Posting of Foundational Positions (AP, Clerk, and School Counselor) and teacher and staff positions
- End of November 2025: Foundational positions hired
- December June 2026: Hiring of teachers and support staff
- January May 2026: Final planning in conjunction with Advisory Councils and Design Committees
- July 1, 2026: Opening Day
