CPS will be absorbing the Casas, Cisneros, Fuentes, Tamayo, and Santiago campuses, incubating them, and re-opening them as CPS-operated schools in the Fall of 2026.

 CPS will lead operations, staffing, and program design, in partnership with families, with the goal of maintaining strong student experiences and identifying opportunities to grow.
