Overview- 900 Points

The maximum number of points that a student can earn for Lincoln Park IB Middle Years Program's point-based system is 900. These points are earned as described below.

CPS High School Admissions Exam 450 Points

We determine the entrance exam points by multiplying the total national percentile rank by 2.2727 to get a maximum score of 225 so that English Language Arts and Math together yield a maximum of 450 points. You can use the table below to determine your exam score.

Seventh Grade Grades 450 Points

Points are calculated for reading, mathematics, science, and social studies. Each 'A' grade is worth 112.5 points, each 'B' is worth 75 points, and each 'C' is worth 38 points. No points are awarded for a 'D' or an 'F' grade.

For example, a student with four As will get a maximum of 450 points, while two As and two Bs are worth 375 points. You can use the GRADES table to determine your point totals.
