Students who have a healthy mouth can have a health start. The state requires for CPS to ensure that students in grades K, 2nd, 6th and 9th have a proof of dental exam. Every school year we work to provide dental exams for students in need

Consent forms

In partnership with CDPH, we provide Dental Providers who offer preventative services at no cost to families, as long as the student has a signed consent form



Once the school has collected the dental consent forms, the provider will work with the school to schedule the dental exams. Call your school to see if they will offer dental this school year





Referral

Our providers make sure to provide families with referrals closer to home to help families find their medical home.
