

You can decide how to use your UER or SSCA remedy funds from the options below. For more information, check out cps.edu/ssca, or email ssca@cps.edu.

1. Chromebook
 - Your student can receive a chromebook, plus the remedies of your choice listed below.
2. CPS-Approved Vendors and Providers
 - 1-year subscriptions to educational and social/emotional software programs. See the list of [District Pre-Approved Vendors](#).
 - Tutoring and supplemental services from CPS teachers, such as tutoring and counseling. See below for additional details.
3. Parent Reimbursement
 - If you paid for educational services outside of school, you can be paid back for the cost. To be reimbursed, fill out the Reimbursement Form (in [English](#) or [Spanish](#)).
 - You **must provide** receipts or other proof of payment for services to be paid back.
 - These are some examples of services that you can be reimbursed for: tutoring, therapy, sports programs, music and art programs, and camps. For more examples, see the Reimbursement Example List in [English](#) or [Spanish](#).
4. Parent-Recommended Vendor
 - If you want to use a provider that is not already a District Pre-Approved Vendor, you can request that they become a vendor so that the District can pay them directly. If the provider is approved, then you can use your remedy for services from that provider.
5. Travel Costs
 - If your student needs transportation to or from their service provider, you can use your UER or SSCA remedy funds to pay for it. **You will need to submit proof of travel costs to be paid back.**
 - Travel costs include: CTA fare, cab or rideshare, and/or driving your student. If you drive, you will submit proof of mileage (i.e.: how far you drove to and from the location and how many times), and will be paid back using the IRS-approved mileage rate for the year.

Tutoring and Related Services from CPS Staff Members

The following 1:1 services are available:

- Tutoring in reading and math programs
- Homework help and executive functioning support
- Social work, counseling, and school psychologist support

Services can be provided:

- Before school
- After school
- Weekends
- Summer and school breaks

Locations:

- Virtual services provided using Google platforms
- Student's school

The SSCA team or UER Caller will work to match the student with a teacher or related service provider, based on your request for type of service, time of service, and location. If a match is possible, you will work directly with the teacher or related service provider to schedule sessions. If there are problems and you need a change, contact ssca@cps.edu to request a new provider or new remedy for the remainder of your funds.
