





# Wellness Check

# Get your child's yearly physical examination by: October 15<sup>th</sup>

This applies to all students enrolling in CPS for the first time and students who are entering pre-k, kindergarten, sixth grade, and ninth grade.

Get your child's vision examination by:

#### October 15th

This applies to students who are entering kindergarten or any student who is entering CPS for the first time at any grade level.

Get your child's dental examination by:

### May 15th

This applies to students in kindergarten, second grade, sixth grade, and ninth grade.

## **Immunizations Requirement**

Immunizations against the following diseases are required at a student's time of enrollment or no later than **October 15**<sup>th</sup> (unless an Illinois Certificate of Religious Exemption Form is received). Failure to do so can result in their being temporarily excluded from school until the child is documented as meeting the state's minimum health requirements.

- Diphtheria, Pertussis, and Tetanus (DTaP/Tdap)
- Polio (IPV)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)
- Haemophilus influenzae, type B (Hib)
- Invasive Pneumococcal Disease (PCV)
- Hepatitis B (Hep B)
- Varicella (VAR; Chickenpox)
- Meningococcal Disease (MenACWY; MCV4)

Submit your child's Asthma Action Plan or any other medical plan at the time of registration. Updated physician orders are required annually or with any change to the health plan.
